All Families are sent a Welcome to AP 4 email upon completion of their home study.

If you did not receive this email contact your FCCA office and let them know you want to take this course and you will be sent a Welcome to AP 4 email.

To sign up for the AP 4 Online follow the steps in the Welcome Email

AP 4 is a required class for all families.

AP 4 Online can only be taken after your home study is complete or you have finalized an adoption.

You will receive 12 hours of training for your one-year recertification training requirement, if you are an active family.

AP 4 Online is a Four Module Class:

Introduction, Empowering, Connecting and Correcting.

They must be taken in this order. & you must complete one before you can start the next one.
